



A LITTLE ABOUT

Maxine Patterson began teaching dance in 1969 at the May St. YMCA. This was the beginning of a wonderful career that is now in its 34th year. Mrs. Patterson now owns her studio on Lincoln & 39th, and has classes at the JEA, Savannah Country Day School, Maggie's Morning School, and St. Francis Cabrini School. There are about 200 students currently enrolled and 6 contracted instructors. Her students perform around the city for various functions, including the Black Heritage Festival, sorority events, senior housing programs and shows in the malls. The most recent performances were for the Gulfstream Management Association, and for the opening ceremonies for the Weightlifting competition. Mrs. Patterson is now teaching many second-generation Maxine Patterson students.

Joanne Lee of Atlanta was the choreographer for "La Boutique Fantasque". Ms. Lee is originally from Australia where she danced professionally before moving to Beaufort & opening a dance school. While there, Ms. Lee came to Savannah on weekends to direct the Junior Company of Savannah Ballet Guild. A few years later, Joanne moved to Atlanta to become an instructor at the Atlanta Ballet School. She was artistic director of the apprentice company for many years, giving her the opportunity to teach and choreograph for hundreds of dance students.

Candice Nash, a native of Savannah, began dancing at age 6 and became a member of Ballet South when she was 11. A graduate of Windsor Forest High School and a member of the marching band there, Candice graduated from Florida A & M in 1998. While in college, she marched in the "FAMU Marching 100" and performed in Orchesis Contemporary Dance Theatre. She received some excellent dance training throughout her college years and is presently an instructor at Maxine Patterson School of Dance.

James Lee, Guest Artist Mr. Lee danced with the Atlanta Ballet for 10 years, while dancing as a guest artist with other companies throughout the South. Favorite roles include principal and soloist performances in Candy Canes of *The Nutcracker* and the Prince in *Cinderella*.



That night, the other dolls figure out a plan to keep their friends from being separated. When the dolls do not arrive as promised, the families return to the toyshop to check on them. They get quite upset when the boxes are found to be empty. The dolls are triumphant in the end.
